Subject: Release of Building 4059

Dear Ms. Lee:

Phase I of the B4059 decontamination and demolition included all above ground structures, plus below ground structures down to the basement level. The Phase I portion of Building 4059 has now undergone a final status radiological survey by Boeing, and a verification survey by the Oak Ridge Institute of Science and Education (ORISE). Both surveys confirmed that the federal cleanup limits in Regulatory Guide 1.86 and DOE Order 5400.5 have been met. Subsequently, the EPA confirmed that federal cleanup limits had been met.

Therefore the facility is suitable for release for unrestricted use. Approval is given for building demolition. The building debris may be disposed of as conventional waste. However in compliance with the Governor Davis' September 2002 moratorium on decommissioned wastes, the building debris should be disposed of at a Class I hazardous waste landfill or a Class 2 industrial waste landfill.
