Radiologic Health Branch (RHB) staff has reviewed the above referenced documents that you submitted for release/demolition of the buildings T373 and T375 for unrestricted use.

The review of the submitted documents indicated that you had conducted a comprehensive survey/measurement of the said buildings for both fixed and removable contamination. The results of the surveys performed in 1988 showed no contamination exceeding the current regulatory limits for unrestricted release. Therefore, RHB concurs that buildings T373 and T375 may be released for unrestricted use.
