
This letter serves to formally request a time extension for the Closure of the
Radioactive Materials Handling Facility.

Due to the technical complexity of safely performing the RMHF Closure activities
in areas containing residual radioactivity, closure will exceed the period of one
hundred eighty days. It is anticipated the decontamination and demolition of the
RMHF (including the regulatory closure activities) will require thirty-nine months
with the additional constraint of Federal funding.


California Code of Regulations Title 22, Section 66265.113(b)(1)(A) provides the
Department of Toxic Substances Control with the authority to grant an extension if
the final closure activities will, of necessity, take longer than 180 days to complete.
This formal request is being made at the direction of the DTSC to satisfy the
requirements of 22 CCR 265.113(e)(2).
