RE: Rocketdyne's letter dated July 6, 1995 with attachments concerning the release of Buildings T029, T028 and OCY.

Radiologic Health Branch (RHB) staff has reviewed the above documents submitted for concurrence of release of buildings T028, T029 and the Old Conservation Yard (OCY) for unrestricted use. The review showed that a comprehensive survey for both fixed and removable contamination had been conducted.

The results of the surveys performed on September 14, 1995 by RHB staff showed no residual contamination exceeding the current limits for unrestricted release. Therefore, RHB concurs that buildings T028, T029, and the OCY may be released for unrestricted use.
